

## **MINUTES OF ECCO COMMITTEE MEETING February 10, 2010**

Moved Nick King, seconded Tony Smith, that the minutes of the committee meeting of January 13 be accepted. Carried.

**BUSINESS ARISING: ECCO Pamphlet:** As agreed at the above meeting, Stephen Nugent has developed a pamphlet designed for general distribution for the purpose of advertising ECCO to the general public. Stephen tabled the pamphlet, which was approved by the committee. Moved Tony Smith, seconded Col. Foster that quotes be obtained for the printing of 500/1000 copies of the pamphlet. Congratulations and thanks to Stephen for his excellent work .

**Local Environment Awards:** Moved Stephen Nugent, seconded Jenny Smith that the ECCO local environment awards be changed to a more flexible format. The normal nomination processes will still apply, but awards will be given as appropriate nominations are received, rather than on a strict seasonal basis. It was also agreed that more flexibility of award categories was necessary. Nominations have been received and will be discussed at the next general meeting.

**Website:** Stephen Nugent reports that he continues to liaise with ECCO's website designer. He will be seeking greater access to the website to enable important changes and updates to be made quickly and independently, to provide a dynamic and up to date website. ECCO has received excellent feedback for our website, thanks to Stephen's excellent work.

**Clean Up Australia Day: (March 7)** Peter West has met with the Tidy Towns committee, who will also be involved with the organization of Clean up Australia Day.

ECCO has registered 5 sites, which are: Moulder Park, Elephant Park, Somerset Park, Gosling Creek Reserve, Hill Park. There will be cleanup sessions at Elephant Park, Moulder Park and Somerset Park from 10am to 12pm, followed by a barbecue from 12pm to 1pm. From 1 to 2.30pm cleanup sessions will be conducted at Gosling Creek reserve and Hill Park.

Media advertising for Clean up Australia Day will be organised through ECCO's Earth First column, ABC radio, commercial radio, community radio, Orange photo news. Flyers advertising the event will be distributed .
